- April 16 *Maryland Coastal Bays Beach Sweep and Bay Kayak Clean Up* – Help keep the coastal bays pristine by collecting any trash we find in the water and along the salt marshes as we paddle Assawoman and Isle of Wight Bays.
- April 28 – May 1 *Delmarva Birding Weekend* – Observe a host of shore birds, songbirds, and raptors. Select from one of our many observation tours including sunrise and sunset paddles.
